

LGBTQ Health Section 2024 Section Survey Highlights

Of the 318 respondents to TMA's [2024 Section Survey](#), 14 (or 4% of the total) were from the LGBTQ Health Section (LGBTQHS).

- The majority of LGBTQHS respondents cited **policy and advocacy** (93%) as their primary reason for section participation.
- When asked what type of **advocacy initiative** was most important, they ranked public health/patient advocacy the highest (69%) followed by legislative/regulatory/legal advocacy (23%).
- When they were asked to drill down on topics of interest within policy and advocacy, LGBTQHS respondents' top responses were:
 - Language and issue framing (27%);
 - Grassroots advocacy and relationship building (22%);
 - Legislative testimony training (22%); and
 - Rulemaking vs. laws (12%).
